I love the stately beauty of delphiniums but like many gardeners am often frustrated by their fussy nature. The New Millennium hybrids are bred for strong stems and greater survival in our less than ideal growing conditions. These delphiniums have divided, mid-green foliage and heavily petalled flowers that have large florets of shimmering blue and deep purple petal combinations in June. May rebloom in fall if spent flowers are removed. Blossoms have excellent color and form, with large florets, and are said to be hardier and longer lived, as they tolerate heat and humidity better than other varieties. Attracts butterflies and is a superb cut flower! Grow in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Feed with a liquid or slow release fertilizer. This plant is hardy in zone 4.
