Pink Flame provides the beauty of garden phlox without the disease problems. I like the look the smaller stature and unique flowers provide. These dwarf plants have narrow, mildew resistant foliage with heads of sweetly fragrant, rich pink flowers with dark, hot pink centers in July-August. This old-fashioned favorite is ideal for the perennial border, cottage garden or rock garden. Large, showy flowers attract hummingbirds and butterflies. Grow in average, moist soil in full sun. Feed with a liquid or slow release fertilizer. This plant is hardy in zone 4.
