Popular for its slug resistance, and sharing the name of a botanic garden in my hometown of Ohio, this is one Hosta I just had to add to my garden last year. The beautiful foliage brightened the shady corners of my garden and remained slug free for me. This large, broad Hosta has heart shaped, puckered, bright yellow-gold foliage with dark green edges and lavender, almost white flowers. The backbone of many shade gardens, Hostas are ideally grown grouped under trees, rambling through shrubby borders, as an edging plant, groundcover, or specimen plant. Combine with Astilbes and Ferns for a textured garden display. Ideally grown in partial shade to shade in rich, moist to well-drained soil. This plant is hardy in zones 3-8.
