I love the classic form and impressive blooms of the Bearded Iris in my garden. Mother Earth showcases fragrant oyster pink standards infused with beige centers and lilac falls that are accented by a warm, honey-orange colored beard. This Iris even blooms twice - once in spring and again in fall! I find the gray-green, sword-like foliage adds important structure to my garden even after the blooms are finished. It is ideal when planted in mixed perennial borders and cottage gardens. This Iris variety would be a superb cut flower in arrangements, and also attracts birds and butterflies. Hardy in Zone 3.
