Compact growth and large flowers make Coconut Lime a favorite in my garden. This coneflower has flower heads with a ring of white petals, like a hula skirt, that surround a large pom-pom of pale green florets. It is the first double white coneflower available and can produce up to 20 blooms on one plant! The flowers attract butterflies and the seed heads attract songbirds to the landscape in fall. It is a fast grower that is perfect for planting in the border garden, prairie garden, or in containers. Use as a cut flower in fresh or dried arrangements. Grow this coneflower in full to part sun in rich, well-drained soil. It blooms from July to September and is hardy in Zones 4-9.
