Even though this Joe-Pye Weed will reach four feet tall, it is a smaller, garden-friendly cultivar that I find is easier to plant in the landscape. Little Joe provides fresh color to the late summer and fall landscape with round clusters of dramatic flower heads that make an architectural statement. Butterflies love the intense fragrance of the mauve flowers that bloom in August to September. Grow this plant along woodland edges, streams or water features. It makes a superb cut flower and an attractive addition to rain gardens. Leave the seed heads and plants for winter interest. Grow this plant in part sun to part shade in rich, moist soil. It is hardy in Zones 4-8, but is late to emerge in spring.
