Versatile and easy to care for, I find daylilies are a refreshing sight in the garden that will give year after year of enjoyment. Carefree and colorful, Strawberry Candy has been developed for its vibrant, long lasting color. The magnificent 4½" strawberry-pink blooms have distinctive rose-red eyes and golden-green throat that explode in color on tall stems. The ruffled flowers bloom in early to mid-summer and will even give you several bursts of flowers in one season. This daylily is rapidly becoming one of the most popular daylilies on the market and is superb for cut flower arrangements. I like to plant my daylilies in the perennial border or use them as a groundcover. They attract birds and butterflies to my garden and I find the grass-like foliage makes them perfect for naturalizing along woodland edges. Plant in full sun to part shade in moist, well-drained soil. This variety will benefit from regular division and light fertilization in spring. Winner of the Stout Medal in 1998, which is the American Hemerocallis Society's most prestigious award. Hardy in Zone 3.
