I think this vine's beautiful trumpet-shaped flowers, and its appeal to hummingbirds, makes it a good addition to any landscape. Madame Galen displays shrubby, coarse foliage that is a lustrous dark green with a spectacular show of flower clusters in mid-summer that are a deep orange-apricot. The dense branching structure also provides shelter for many other types of birds. I have seen this rampant, twining vine climb on stone, wood, fenceposts, or most anything in its path, creating a mass of foliage once it reaches the top. This vine is also tastefully used as a privacy screen, or as a covering for trellises or lath structures. It prefers full sun in moist, well-drained soil, but will grow in most any growing condition. Its aggressive nature means that it needs yearly pruning in late winter to early spring to keep it in bounds. However, once the pruning is finished, so is the yearly maintenance; so sit back, relax, and enjoy the show. Apply a 2-3" layer of mulch or organic material to conserve moisture and improve the soil. Hardy in Zones 5-9.
