I feel Boxwood hedges, with their compact and dense, evergreen foliage, evoke thoughts of English gardens. They are slow growing and maintain a good, green color even in winter. They bloom in early spring with tiny, white flowers that are fragrant, but not very showy. I find that it is best to plant these shrubs where they are protected from the drying winter sun and wind; burlap or other windbreaks may offer added protection. The roots prefer cool, moist growing conditions. This is an excellent shrub for hedges, foundations, edging, and formal gardens. Boxwoods have long been used as sheared hedges in the formal landscapes of Europe and the Southern United States; however, be careful not to shear Boxwoods beyond recognition, or their natural beauty is destroyed. Grow in full sun to part shade and moist soil. Apply a 2-3" layer of mulch or organic material to conserve moisture and improve the soil. Hardy in Zones 5-9.
