INTEREST

I am always impressed with the vibrant foliage and flower color this dwarf shrub displays throughout the seasons. In early spring, bright, green-gold foliage is accented with striking red leaf tips, changing to bronze in autumn. Semi-double, deep pink-purple flowers bloom in early spring and nearly cover the plant by early to mid-summer. If pruned after the first flowering, a second flush of blooms will occur in early fall. The dried flowerheads create winter interest. Magic Carpet's low spreading habit is ideal in the rock garden, as a groundcover, or in the shrub border. This medium to fast growing Spirea thrives in full to part sun in most any moist, well-drained soil. Apply a 2-3" layer of mulch or organic material to conserve moisture and improve the soil. Hardy in Zones 4-9.
