When Snowmound is in bloom I cannot think of any other shrubs that are more classy or exquisite than this one. The dark blue-green foliage displays clusters of fragrant, pure white flowers that literally smother the stems and foliage in early summer for three to four weeks. This compact mounded shrub with graceful, spreading, arching branches is perfect as a specimen, accent, or informal hedge. It can also be planted in masses in the shrub border, entranceway, or used as a foundation shrub. Apply a 2-3" layer of mulch or organic material to conserve moisture and improve the soil. Prune this shrub after the flowers have finished blooming; prune older, larger canes to the ground to thin and rejuvenate. This moderate grower thrives in full to part sun in most any well-drained soil. It also withstands wind, is urban tolerant, and adaptable to poor, dry, or even clay soils. Hardy in Zones 4-8.
