I like to use this evergreen's naturally shaped appearance and stately, pyramidal form in the landscape. This perfect cone-shaped dwarf conifer displays dense gray-green needles which are soft to the touch. In spring the new needles emerge fluffy-soft and bright green. Excellent in containers or as a miniature Christmas tree. Makes a formal statement in rock gardens, small landscapes, dwarf evergreen collections, as a focal point, specimen plant, or in pairs as an entranceway shrub. Plant in an area with good air circulation and protect from winter sun and salt spray. Extremely slow-growing, only 2-4" per year. It is considered "no maintenance" in regard to pruning and shearing. Apply a 2-3" layer of mulch or organic material to conserve moisture and improve the soil. Thrives in full to part sun in moist, well-drained soil. Hardy in Zones 2-8.
