I feel the late blooms, from July to frost, are this flowering shrub's greatest asset. This old-time favorite has large, white, saucer-shaped flowers with a dark, reddish-purple throat that provide a welcome color accent in summer. Helene has a longer blooming season, superior flowers and a more dense, compact growth habit. Plant Helene as a valuable specimen plant in the shrub border, or in mass as a hedge or screen, where the amazing flowers can be enjoyed! It attracts hummingbirds and has chocolate-brown fruit capsules that provide winter interest. In spring, prune back main branches and side shoots to 2 to 3 buds for an impressive flower display. Thrives in full to part sun in moist, well-drained soil. Apply a 2-3" layer of mulch or organic material to conserve moisture and improve the soil. Hardy in Zones 5-9.
