I recommend planting this vine where you can enjoy the lightly fragrant flowers and hummingbirds that will come to visit. This handsome, climbing vine produces generous clusters of carmine buds that open into lovely, trumpet-shaped, bright coral-pink flowers with yellow centers! The blue-green, showy foliage is tinged with violet when new. Goldflame is one of the best climbing honeysuckles, creating a profusion of color over trellises, arbors, and fences. Blooms from spring to frost with red berries in the fall. This fast grower thrives in moist, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Apply a 2-3" layer of mulch or organic material to conserve moisture and improve the soil. Hardy in Zones 4-9.
