PRUNE LATE WINTER/
EARLY SPRING

I love the architectural structure of this outstanding evergreen groundcover. The twiggy branchlets are covered with rich, green foliage that is tinged purple in fall, and enhanced with a profusion of coral-red berries that persist through winter. Blooms in late spring with small, bright white flowers. It is important to prune your established plants in late winter or early spring before growth begins. Coral Beauty is ideally planted in moist, well-drained soil, but it will tolerate dry conditions and even winter salt spray. Apply a 2-3" layer of mulch or organic material to conserve moisture and improve the soil. Hardy in Zones 5-8.
