

Homemade Dried/Silk Flower Vase

Items You Will Need

- Corrugated Cardboard from the recycling bin
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Colored paper
- Pencils, markers, stickers, and /or paint
- Dried or silk flowers

Get Started

Draw a picture of a vase on the cardboard. Make sure there is a flat bottom to support the vase. The channels in the corrugated cardboard should run from top to bottom. These tubes will hold the flowers in place.

Next

Cut out your vase.

Use this as a guide. Trace at least three more vases (make sure the channels run from top to bottom) and cut them out.

Glue the layers together.

Get Creative

Decorate the outside of the cardboard vase with colorful pieces of construction paper, stickers, crayons, markers and/or paint.

The Final Touch

Now fill the channels in the cardboard with dried or silk flowers. Use mom's favorite flowers or her favorite colors.

You just created a long lasting beautiful memory for mom to keep on her desk, night stand or kitchen counter.
