TRYING NEW PLANTS

It is always fun to try growing new plants each year. I often "trial" them in containers to see how they perform before buying a large quantity for my planting beds. I also like using them as a focal point since new introductions are often more expensive. I mix them with some favorites that have been around for a while and cost less. This helps me stretch my plant budget while filling my landscape with beautiful flowers and gardens with tasty vegetables.

ANNUALS

You will notice hardiness zones for some of these plants. These are perennials, returning each year in the garden, in areas where they are hardy. The rest of us have to treat them as annuals and replant each year or overwinter them indoors.

BIDENS 'CAMPFIRE® FLAME'

- Full sun
- Moist, well-drained soil (some drought)
- 8-14" (20-36cm) x 10-18" (25-46cm)
- Heat tolerant
- No deadheading
- Zones 9 to 11

CALIBRACHOA 'CALITASTIC® TRICOLOR PINK'

- Full sun
- Well-drained soil (drought tolerant)
- 6-8" (15-20cm) x 8-12" (20-31cm)
- Early flowering
- Attracts birds & butterflies
- Deer resistant

CELOSIA 'TWISTED™ RED CURRANT'

- Full sun
- Well-drained soil
- 16-20" (41-51cm) x 10-14" (30-36cm)
- Great cut flower fresh and dried

COLEUS 'COLORBLAZE® MINI ME™ WATERMELON'

- Sun to shade
- Moist, organic soil
- 12-20" (30-51cm) x 10-18" (25-46cm)
- Heat tolerant
- No deadheading
- Smaller than other in series
- Zones 10 to 11

COLEUS 'COLORBLAZE® TORCHLIGHT®'

- Sun to shade
- Moist, organic soil
- 24-40" (61-102cm) x 18-36" (46-91cm)
- Heat tolerant
- No deadheading
- Zones 10 to 11



In Wisconsin file online at diggershotline.com or anywhere in the U.S., including Wisconsin, call 811 at least 3 business days before putting the first shovel in the ground. Once your request is received, Diggers Hotline (or your local locating service) contacts all the appropriate underground utilities. The utility's locators will mark the location of the underground utilities in the work area. Avoid digging near the marks to reduce the risk of damage, personal injury or even death.

Cotinus coggygria

- Full sun

- Leaves emerge purple, turn deep purpleblack
- Red & orange fall color
- Blooms early summer, followed by wispy seed heads
- Rounded, dwarf habit
- Zones 4 to 8

AUTUMN RADIANCE RED MAPLE

Acer rubrum

- Full sun
- Moist, acidic soil
- Up to 50' (15m) x 40' (12m)
- Red flowers and seeds in spring
- Red fall color
- Zones 4 to 8

WEEPING GREEN JAPANESE MAPLE

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Viridis'

- Part sun
- Moist, well-drained soil
- 6-8' (1.9-2.4m) x 8-10' (2.4-3m)
- Green, lacy leaves turn golden red in fall
- Zones 5 to 8


